Power Trading Results

In December 2020, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 117.6 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 62.8 TWh which includes 0.7 TWh from German Power.

Electricity Certificates Trading Results

In December 2020, the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 723 thousand EI-Certs.

Carbon Trading Results

In December 2020, the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.197 million tonnes.
