Power Trading Results

In October 2021, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 64.2 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 33.2 TWh which includes 0.7 TWh from German Power.

In October 2021, the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 236 thousand El-Certs.

Carbon Trading Results

In October 2021, the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 66 thousand tonnes.
