Power Trading Results

In November 2021, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 57.7 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 29.6 TWh which includes 0.3 TWh from German Power.

Electricity Certificates Trading Results

In November 2021, the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 97 thousand El-Certs.

Carbon Trading Results In November 2021, the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 62 thousand tonnes.
