Nasdaq Commodities Oslo, 3 July 2017

Power Trading Results in June 2017

In June 2017, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 91.1 TWh (June 2016: 165.6 TWh). The share of Order Book traded power was 46.0 TWh (June 2016: 86.0 TWh) which includes 7.5 TWh from German Power (June 2016: 18.8 TWh).

Electricity Certificates Trading Results in June 2017

In June 2017 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 1.35 million El-Certs as compared to 1.20 million El-Certs in June 2016. The share of Order Book traded El-Certs was 0.02 million El-Certs (June 2016: 0.08 million El-Certs).

Carbon Trading Results in June 2017

In June 2017 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.02 million tonnes as compared to 0.18 million tonnes in June 2016.
