## **Power Trading Results in January 2019**

In January 2019, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 88.9 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 37.0 TWh which includes 1.9 TWh from German Power.

# **Electricity Certificates Trading Results in January 2019**

In January 2019 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 2.04 million El-Certs. The share of Order Book traded El-Certs was 0.02 million El-Certs.

# **Carbon Trading Results in January 2019**

In January 2019 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.08 million tonnes.
